## Nisga'a Community Support Initiatives

### Purpose:

- The Nisga'a Community Support Initiatives (NCSI) is funded by Nisga'a Lisims Government
- This is an initiative to encourage our youth to be more involved in recreational activities; which may include sports, movies, cultural-based activities, camp etc.
- This fund can be accessed for individual or group activities. To apply for group activities, you must provide a proposed outline and budget for your activity to be reviewed and approved by the NTVS Board.



### How to Apply:

1. Obtain and fill out the NCSI application form:
  - online at [www.tsamiks.com](http://www.tsamiks.com) under applications and forms;
  - by calling our office and requesting a form be faxed to you;
  - by picking a form up at our downtown office.
2. Gather supporting documentation for the recreational activity that your dependant is registered for or is already participating in (i.e. copy of the brochure page with activity details and or receipt of payment).
3. Complete an NCSI application. Incomplete applications will cause delay in the processing of your application. (Please note that you will be required to provide the citizenship number for both you and your dependant.)
4. Submit your NCSI application form and your supporting document(s) to our office:
  - by fax at (604) 646-4955;
  - in person.

### Annual Assistance Available:

- Up to 5 years of age a maximum of \$50.00
- 6 - 12 years of age a maximum of \$100.00
- 13 - 18 years of age a maximum of \$150.00

Please note that processing time for the NCSI application, once all required information has been provided, can take up to 2 weeks.

### In the Works:

NTVS is looking at ways to organize community recreational initiatives throughout the GVRD, Nanaimo, and Victoria regions to accommodate more of our membership.
